Comments: I wish to comment on the APS 2014 Rooftop Solar Program proposal. Under the APS proposal the homeowners will receive a fixed \$30 per month credit for what is effectively just a 20 year lease of rooftop space, with no adjustment for inflation. The rooftop space is relatively secure compared to leasing vacant commercial land which would require at least a perimeter fence and some period of monitored security. The homeowner gets no power from the panels on their rooftop, just the \$30 per month credit. Today, that would buy dinner for two in a modest restaurant. In 5 years ago that same meal cost \$22. At that rate of inflation, that same meal will cost \$58 This proposal is extremely biased in favor of APS with little benefit to the homeowner, especially in the later years of the lease. At a minimum, the credit should be indexed against the cost of living to maintain a constant benefit for the homeowner. Alternatively, the homeowner should be able to choose the use of the power generated as a credit against the power consumed at the residence. thanks for your consideration,
