The scholarly scientific **BioInitiative** reports of **2007** and **2012** are well regarded in sophisticated circles. The BioInitiative 2012 Working Group comprises notable participants from ten countries. I selected the 26 page Summary for the Public as being practical for us to access.

The study ends up recommending 0.3 nanowatts to 0.6 nanowatts per square centimeter as a reasonable, precautionary action level for chronic exposure to pulsed RFR.

The 1800 new studies reviewed since 2007, report abnormal

gene transcriptions; genotoxicity of single and double-strand DNA damage and loss of DNA repair capacity; carcinogenicity; neurotoxicity; serious human and animal sperm function; effects on fetus, neonate and offspring; effects on brain and cranial bone development; autism spectrum disorders consistent with EMF/RFR exposure and many other new discoveries.

The levels at which effects are reported to occur is lower by hundreds of times in comparison to 2007.

The most serious health endpoints that have been reported to be associated with extremely low frequency (ELF) and/or radio frequency radiation (RFR) include childhood and adult leukemia, childhood and adult brain tumors, and increased risk of the neurodegenerative diseases, Alzheimer's and amyotrophic lateral sclerosis (ALS). In addition, there are reports of increased risk of breast cancer in both men and women, genotoxic effects (DNA damage, chromatin condensation, micronucleation, impaired repair of DNA damage in human stem cells), pathological leakage of the blood-brain barrier, altered immune function including increased allergic and inflammatory responses, miscarriage and some cardiovascular effects.

WIRELESS WARNINGS FOR ALL

The continued rollout of wireless technologies and devices puts global public health at risk from unrestricted wireless commerce unless new, and far lower exposure limits and strong precautionary warnings for their use are implemented.

EMF AND RFR ARE PREVENTABLE TOXIC EXPOSURES

We have the knowledge and means to save global populations from multi-generational adverse health consequences by reducing both ELF and RFR exposures. Proactive and immediate measures to reduce unnecessary EMF exposures will lower disease burden and rates of premature death.¹

From the point of view of meter reading, one can easily take a photo with a date on it and email it to APS.²



APS has demonstrated its lack of responsibility relative to abiding by Arizona Revised Statute 40-361.B. APS has also failed to inform the public about the hazards of what I now call "not-so-smart-APS-AMI-WMD."³

The collective information contained in the BioInitiative Color Charts certainly makes a good case that **informed consent does not exist in APS territory.** **The truth about "Smart-AMI-WMD" harm has not been shared with the public by APS! Instead, APS does its best to cover up, spin or lie about the multiple forms of harm APS prefers to do to all of us.**
