Based on the figures supplied by EPCOR, each Sun City West wastewater user would experience a 90% rate increase if full-district consolidation was to be approved by the Commission.

EPCOR noted in their ACC response they have projected additional capital improvement costs for the Sun City West District of \$9.3M over the next five years. If a full consolidation were to take place, Sun City West users would be required to pay an additional \$22.5M over the noted five-year period. This equates to subsidizing other district costs in the amount of \$13.2M. We cannot and should not be required to subsidize other districts for poor planning and choices. What EPCOR is asking for is a blank check and getting the consumers, to pay for it. We need to keep all of the utility companies in check so the customers are not paying for these frivolous ideas.

Basically, adjuster mechanisms allow rates to go up between rate cases as utility companies want to be protected for declining usage and other unfavorable factors. While that may be appropriate to assure that EPCOR has the ability to provide safe and sufficient water and wastewater services to Sun City, the issue is that the rate does not go down if there is an increase in usage, which is totally not fair.

In addition, some of the adjuster mechanisms are not appropriate such as tank maintenance expenses or employee health care costs, operating costs controllable by the corporation.

It is so sad that these large corporations want to do all of this on the backs of the senior population in Sun City.
