Pursuant to A.A.C. R-14-3-106 (K), Lawrence V. Robertson, Jr. ("Movant") hereby moves for leave to participate telephonically in the forthcoming July 30, 2014 Procedural Conference which has been scheduled in the above-captioned and above-docketed proceeding ("Instant Proceeding"). Movant represented several different intervenors in the general rate case proceedings previously conducted in the Instant Proceeding. In that regard, only one of those intervenors has requested that Movant participate in the current phase of the Instant Proceeding, which involves the Four Corners Rate Rider Adjustor Provision proposed by Arizona Public Service Company. That Intervenor is Noble Americas Energy Solutions LLC ("Solutions").

In that regard, Noble Solutions has collaborated with Intervenor Freeport-McMoRan Copper & Gold, Inc. ("Freeport McMoRan")/Arizonans for Electric Choice and Competition ("AECC") and The Kroger Co. in submitting the prepared Direct Testimony and prepared Surrebuttal Testimony of Kevin C. Higgins on behalf of the aforesaid Intervenor and Noble Solutions. In addition, counsel for Freeport McMoRan and AECC has taken the lead among counsel for the aforesaid Intervenor in presenting their collaborative position to date.

Against the above background, Movant anticipates that his role in the forthcoming July 30,


