BY THE COMMISSION:

Having considered the entire record herein and being fully advised in the premises, the Arizona Corporation Commission (“Commission”) finds, concludes, and orders that:

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FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On September 7, 2004, the Commission issued Decision No. 67235 granting FSH Communications, LLC (“FSH” or “Applicant”) a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (“CC&N”) to provide customer-owned pay telephone (“COPT”) service within the State of Arizona.

2. On June 10, 2014, FSH filed an application with the Commission requesting approval to cancel its CC&N to provide COPT services in Arizona. The application indicated FSH no longer provides, or never did provide, COPT services in the State of Arizona. The application also stated that FSH waived its right to notice and a hearing in order to cancel the CC&N.

3. On July 22, 2014, the Commission’s Utilities Division (“Staff”) filed a Memorandum in response to FSH’s application to cancel its CC&N. In the Memorandum, Staff states Mr. Michael Johnson indicated he was authorized to file the application on behalf of the Applicant. Further, Staff states that the Commission’s Consumer Services Section reported that no complaints, inquires, or

1 opinions have been filed against FSH since January 1, 2011. According to Staff, the Applicant is in
2 good standing with the Commission's Corporations Division and the Commission's Compliance
3 Section reports that the Applicant is in compliance.

4 4. Staff recommends approval of FSH's application to cancel its CC&N.

5 5. Staff's recommendation to approve FSH's application for cancellation of its CC&N is
6 reasonable and should be adopted.

7 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

8 1. FSH is a public service corporation within the meaning of Article XV of the Arizona
9 Constitution and A.R.S. §§ 40-281 and 40-282.

10 2. The Commission has jurisdiction over FSH and the subject matter of the application.

11 3. The cancellation of FSH's CC&N to provide COPT services in Arizona is in the
12 public interest.

13 4. FSH waives its right to notice and a hearing in this matter.

14 5. Staff's recommendation is reasonable and should be adopted.

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ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the application of FSH Communications, LLC for the cancellation of its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to provide customer-owned pay telephone service in Arizona shall be, and is hereby, approved, and the Certificate of Convenience and Necessity is cancelled.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Decision shall become effective immediately.


