Dear Commissioners:

I have never considered rooftop solar. It has nothing to do with my belief in renewable energy or the value of solar, to the contrary.

I fully intend to stay in our home for many years and don't want to install something as "intrusive" as solar panels on my tile roof with no idea if the company would be here to fulfill the "guarantee". I've seen the headlines and the life expectancy of some of these companies isn't something I'm willing to gamble on.

Now, APS has offered to install rooftop solar through a "lease" of homeowner rooftops. I would receive a \$30 a month credit, which is less than the savings solar owners/leases recognize, but without any of the risk.
