Comments: As property owners who have property bordering Cloud Road, we obviously oppose the amendment which would cause a drastic decrease in our property value. Of course many other people in the area have the same concerns. Ours being that we bought our property in 2008 paying in full the high property price at the time. We retired and invested our life savings in this home so that we would have no mortgage and eventually would sell the property to pay for what might end up being long term health care in our later years. Property has since dropped to about half of what we paid due to the economy. With the transmission line running along Cloud Road, the remainder of our life savings would all but be wiped out. There would be no way we could pay for care that will likely be needed. My wife is disabled and already nearly unable to walk. She may need the health care

The argument that the few are sacrificed for the gain of many does not ring true considering that there is the alternative to keep the present corridor for the transmission line and then the "many" will still benefit and the "few" will not be financially ruined.
