18 Pursuant to A.A.C. R14-3-105, Freeport Minerals Corporation (“Freeport”) and

22 Freeport maintains facilities and operations within the State of Arizona, which
23 receive electric services from Arizona Public Service Company (“APS”). As a large
24 industrial user of electric services provided by APS, Freeport will be directly and
25 substantially affected by the issues to be addressed in this proceeding.

26 Freeport’s participation will not broaden the issues nor unduly delay the
proceeding, except upon leave of the Commission first had and received. For the reasons
outlined above, Freeport respectfully requests that the Commission grant this Application
for Leave to Intervene in this matter.


