**SUMMARY OF SURREBUTTAL TESTIMONY OF JENNA KOLLINGS**

Jenna Kollings is testifying that:

22 The Anthem Community Council (the "Community Council" or "Anthem"), which  
 23 represents the interests of over 8,800 Anthem community residents that are water and wastewater  
 24 customers of EPCOR ("EPCOR" or the "Company"), supports full consolidation of all of the  
 25 Company's wastewater districts in Arizona. Anthem emphasizes the importance of honoring the  
 26 Settlement Agreement. To that end, if the Commission does not wish to implement full  
 27 consolidation at this time, Anthem prefers the interim scenario described briefly by Anthem  
 28 witness Neidlinger which would result in the Commission issuing an accounting order to allow

1 Step 3 of the deconsolidated rates approved in Decision No. 73227 to be implemented for Anthem  
2 but not yet for Agua Fria. This approach would allow Anthem to receive the full benefit of the  
3 Settlement Agreement while allowing some relief for Agua Fria customers. In the words of  
4 Commissioner Pierce in the Open Meeting on July 22, 2014: "We really did make a deal with  
5 Anthem and we have to find a way to honor that."


