Dear Chairman and Commissioners,

The current Energy Efficient Standards adopted in 2010 has created thousands of jobs during a recession, saved roughly \$75 million from energy savings, 650 million Kilowatts, and created safe and healthy homes for tens of thousands of Arizona families.

I have been in the residential construction and remodeling industry for well over twenty-five years now. After the collapse of the housing market in 2007, I lost everything. Since then I was able to qualify for grant money and become certified in the energy efficiency field of which now I am employed along with my sister and my wife. The current Energy Efficient Standard that was adopted in 2010 saved my family and countless others from financial ruin. At my company alone, we employ three U.S. veterans, single mothers and fathers, husbands and wives with over twenty-five children who's future is dependent on the current Energy Efficient Standard.

We provide home energy audits and complete contracting services throughout the state of Arizona. We are very pleased with the services and results CED provided and would highly recommend them to anyone interested in reducing their energy costs.


