**PUBLIC NOTICE OF DRAGOON WATER COMPANY, INC.  
FINANCING APPLICATION  
DOCKET NO. W-01917A-14-0312**

On August 22, 2014, Dragoon Water Company, Inc. ("Company" or "Applicant") filed an Application with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") for authority to borrow an amount not to exceed \$26,000.00 to pay for a loan from Southwestern Utility Management Company (Southwestern), which manages the Company. On September 13, 2013, Dragoon's primary well pump failed and the Company did not have the funds to repair the pump. The Company borrowed the funds from Southwestern in order to repair the pump. The purpose of the financing is to repay the outstanding loan. The Commission may approve, disapprove, or approve the financing request with modifications. The Commission may act on the financing request with or without a hearing.

**About Intervention**

Any person or entity entitled by law to intervene and having a direct and substantial interest in the matter will be permitted to intervene. Intervention entitles a person to participate as a party and if a hearing is held, to present sworn testimony and evidence and cross-examine witnesses. Persons who do not intervene will receive no further notice of the proceedings in this docket. The granting of motions to intervene shall be governed by A.A.C. R14-3-105, except that the person requesting intervention must file an original and 13 copies of a written motion to intervene with the Commission's Docket Control Center and must send a copy of the motion to the Company. Each motion to intervene must include the Docket Number and contain the following:

1. The name, address, and telephone number of the person requesting intervention and of any person upon whom service of documents is to be made, if not the same person;

3. Whether the proposed intervenor desires a formal evidentiary hearing on the application and the reasons for such a hearing;

5.
