PROCEDURAL ORDER
(Grants Motion to Consolidate)

On October 25, 2013, the Arizona Corporation Commission (“Commission”) issued Decision No. 74155 which approved an application by Cordes Lakes Water Company (“Applicant” or “Company”) for an increase in its rates and charges.

As a result of Decision No. 74155, the Company was ordered to file, within six months of the effective date of the Decision, with the Commission, an application for financing approval for the cost of improvements to prevent water losses.

On January 7, 2014, the Company filed a request to extend the April 25, 2014 deadline for meeting the above-referenced conditions by 60 to 90 days due to the illness of the Company’s President.

On February 26, 2014, the Commission issued Decision No. 74372 which approved the Company’s request for an extension of time until July 25, 2014, in which to file the above-referenced application for financing approval.

On November 13, 2014, the Company filed the above-captioned application for financing approval in Docket No. 02060A-14-0387.

On November 17, 2014, the Commission’s Utilities Division (“Staff”) filed a Motion to Consolidate (“Motion”) the above-referenced dockets and stated that the Applicant has no objections to the Motion.

1 Accordingly, Staff's Motion to Consolidate the above-captioned dockets should be granted.

2 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Motion to Consolidate the applications of Cordes
3 Lakes Water Company in the above-captioned dockets is hereby granted.

4 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all parties must comply with Rules 31 and 38 of the Rules
5 of the Arizona Supreme Court and A.R.S. § 40-243 with respect to the practice of law and admission
6 *pro hac vice*.

7 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that withdrawal of representation must be made in compliance
8 with A.A.C. R14-3-104(E) and Rule 1.16 of the Rules of Professional Conduct (under Rule 42 of the
9 Rules of the Arizona Supreme Court). Representation before the Commission includes appearances
10 at all hearings and procedural conferences, as well as all Open Meetings for which the matter is
11 scheduled for discussion, unless counsel has previously been granted permission to withdraw by the
12 Administrative Law Judge or the Commission.

13 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113 - Unauthorized
14 Communications) continues to apply to this proceeding and shall remain in effect until the
15 Commission's Decision in this matter is final and non-appealable.

16 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter, amend,
17 or waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at
18 hearing.
