22 Pursuant to A.A.C. R14-3-105, Freeport Minerals Corporation ("Freeport") and
23 Arizonans for Electric Choice and Competition ("AECC") hereby apply to the Arizona
24 Corporation Commission (the "Commission") for an Order granting Freeport and AECC
25 leave to intervene in the above-captioned proceeding.

26 Freeport maintains facilities and operations within the State of Arizona, which
receive electric services from electric utilities who provide services in Arizona. As a large
industrial user of electric services, Freeport will be directly and substantially affected by
the issues to be addressed in this proceeding.

Freeport's participation will not broaden the issues nor unduly delay the
proceeding, except upon leave of the Commission first had and received. For the reasons
outlined above, Freeport respectfully requests that the Commission grant this Application

1 for Leave to Intervene in this matter.

2 AECC is a coalition of energy consumers which has members who are customers
3 that receive electric services from electric utilities who provide services in Arizona. The
4 Commission should grant AECC leave to intervene in this matter because those members
5 of AECC who are customers of electric utilities will be directly and substantially affected
6 by the issues to be addressed in this proceeding.

7 AECC's participation will not broaden the issues nor unduly delay the proceeding,
8 except upon leave of the Commission first had and received. For the reasons outlined
9 above, AECC respectfully requests that the Commission grant this Application for Leave
10 to Intervene in this matter.
