**PROCEDURAL ORDER**  
**(Granting Request to Appear**  
**Telephonically)**

IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION  
OF GC PIVOTAL, LLC DBA GLOBAL  
CAPACITY FOR A CERTIFICATE OF  
CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY TO  
PROVIDE RESOLD AND FACILITIES-  
BASED LOCAL EXCHANGE, RESOLD  
AND FACILITIES-BASED  
INTEREXCHANGE, AND FACILITIES-  
BASED PRIVATE LINE  
TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES IN  
ARIZONA.

**BY THE COMMISSION:**

On October 9, 2014, GC Pivotal, LLC, dba Global Capacity (“GC Pivotal”) filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission (“Commission”) an application for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (“CC&N”), to provide resold and facilities-based local exchange, resold and facilities-based interexchange, and facilities-based private line telecommunications services on a statewide basis in Arizona.

On October 15, 2014, GC Pivotal docketed a signed certification to the application.

On October 28, 2014, GC Pivotal filed its Responses to Commission’s Utilities Division’s (Staff) First Set of Data Requests.

On November 5, 2014, GC Pivotal filed its Responses to Staff’s Second Set of Data Requests.

On December 1, 2014, Staff filed its Staff Report recommending approval of GC Pivotal’s application, subject to certain conditions.

On December 3, 2014, a Procedural Order was issued setting the date for hearing of December 30, 2014, and establishing other procedural deadlines.

On December 4, 2014, GC Pivotal filed a Status of Publication Requirement.

On December 16, 2014, GC Pivotal filed an Affidavit of Publication indicating that notice of

1 the application and hearing date had been published in the *Arizona Republic*, a newspaper of general  
2 circulation in Arizona.

3 On December 18, 2014, GC Pivotal filed a Request to Allow Witness to Appear  
4 Telephonically (“Request”) for the December 30, 2014 hearing, stating the witness was in the midst  
5 of closing a related transaction and it was difficult to travel during the holiday season.

6 Accordingly, the GC Pivotal’s Request should be granted.

7 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the witness for GC Pivotal, LLC is authorized to appear  
8 telephonically at the December 30, 2014 hearing.

9 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that on the date of and at least five minutes before the time set  
10 for the hearing, GC Pivotal’s witness shall call 1 (800) 689-9374, passcode 415962#, from a landline  
11 telephone, to participate telephonically in the evidentiary hearing.

12 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all parties must comply with Arizona Supreme Court Rules  
13 31, 38, and 42 and A.R.S. § 40-243 with respect to practice of law in Arizona and before the  
14 Commission and admission *pro hac vice*.


15 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that withdrawal of representation must be made in compliance  
16 with A.A.C. R14-3-104(E) and Rule 1.16 of the Rules of Professional Conduct (under Arizona  
17 Supreme Court Rule 42). Representation before the Commission includes appearance at all hearings  
18 and procedural conferences, as well as all Open Meetings for which the matter is scheduled for  
19 discussion, unless counsel has previously been granted permission to withdraw by the Administrative  
20 Law Judge or the Commission.

21 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113 - Unauthorized  
22 Communications) applies to this proceeding and shall remain in effect until the Commission's  
23 Decision in this matter is final and non-appealable.
