ARIZONA.

BY THE COMMISSION:

On August 7, 2013, BCN Telecom, Inc. ("BCN" or the "Company") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for approval of a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CC&N") to provide resold local exchange telecommunications services in the State of Arizona. BCN's application also requests a determination that its proposed services are competitive in Arizona.

On April 25, 2014, the Company filed an amendment to its application to include a request for authority to provide facilities-based local exchange telecommunications services.

On May 29, 2014, BCN filed its proposed tariff for its requested services.

On June 6, 2014, BCN filed responses to the Commission's Utilities Division's ("Staff") first set of data requests.

On June 16, 2014, BCN filed additional responses to Staff's first set of data requests.

On July 14, 2014, BCN filed its Certificate of Good Standing.

On September 16, 2014, BCN filed an amended proposed tariff.

On October 24, 2014, BCN filed an amendment to its application.

On November 3, 2014, Jason D. Gellman filed a Notice of Appearance on behalf of BCN.

On December 1, 2014, Staff filed a Staff Report recommending approval of BCN's application, subject to certain conditions.

1 On December 11, 2014, a Procedural Order was issued setting this matter for hearing to begin
2 on February 12, 2015, and establishing other procedural deadlines.

3 On December 19, 2014, a Corrected Procedural Order was issued.

4 On December 22, 2014, BCN filed a Notice of Change of Address.

5 On January 16, 2015, BCN filed a Request to Allow Witness to Appear Telephonically,
6 stating that its witness, Richard Boudria, resides in New Jersey and that appearing telephonically
7 would save time and expenses for this uncontested matter. The filing states that Staff has no
8 objection to the Company's request. Also on the same date, BCN filed a Notice of Filing Affidavit of
9 Publication.

10 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that **BCN's request to allow its witness Mr. Richard**
11 **Boudria, to appear telephonically for the hearing scheduled in this matter is hereby granted.**

12 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that on the date of and at least five minutes before the time
13 set for the hearing, BCN's witness shall call 1-800-689-9374, passcode 415962#, from a landline
14 telephone, to participate telephonically in the hearing.


15 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all parties must comply with Arizona Supreme Court
16 Rules 31, 38, and 42 and A.R.S. § 40-243 with respect to practice of law in Arizona and before the
17 Commission and admission *pro hac vice*.

18 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that withdrawal of representation must be made in compliance
19 with A.A.C. R14-3-104(E) and Rule 1.16 of the Rules of Professional Conduct (under Arizona
20 Supreme Court Rule 42). Representation before the Commission includes appearance at all hearings
21 and procedural conferences, as well as all Open Meetings for which the matter is scheduled for
22 discussion, unless counsel has previously been granted permission to withdraw by the Administrative
23 Law Judge or the Commission.

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1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113 - Unauthorized
2 Communications) applies to this proceeding and shall remain in effect until the Commission's
3 Decision in this matter is final and non-appealable.
