In its Direct Testimony docketed January 23, 2014, Sanctuary Camelback Mountain Resort & Spa, JW Marriott Camelback Inn, and Omni Scottsdale Resort & Spa at Montelucia ("Resorts") raise for the first time the adequacy of the required notice for EPCOR Water of Arizona, Inc.'s ("EWAZ") request for a System Improvement Benefit mechanism ("SIB") for the Paradise Valley Water District. The Resorts are correct that EWAZ failed to docket certain of the mailing certificates confirming the mailing of the notices. Attached to this filing as Exhibit A are copies of those notices along with the applicable mailing certificates.
