

On January 29, 2015, Tierra Buena Water Company, Inc. ("Company" or "Applicant") filed an Application with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") for authority to borrow an amount not to exceed \$899,506.00 to pay for a metered interconnection with Valley Utilities, the rehabilitation of Well 2, and an arsenic treatment facility. The Commission may approve, disapprove, or approve the financing request with modifications. The Commission may act on the financing request with or without a hearing.

#### **About Intervention**
