NOTIFICATION OF
INTERVENTION

BY THE COMMISSION:

On April 14, 2015, Sulphur Springs Valley Electric Cooperative, Inc. ("SSVEC" or "Cooperative") filed an application with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") for: (1) approval of a new Net Metering Tariff Schedule NM-2 that will apply to all future net metered members which credits to a member's account any excess energy produced from an eligible net metering facility on a monthly basis at SSVEC's authorized avoided costs rate; (2) revisions to the Cooperative's existing Net Metering Tariff Schedule NM (to be revised and renamed Net Metering Tariff Schedule NM-1) which provide that members who have an installed eligible net metering facility or an accepted SunWatts Incentive/Interconnection application on file with SSVEC by close of business on April 14, 2015, will be grandfathered under the existing Net Metering Tariff; and (3) approval of a partial waiver of the Commission's net metering rules set forth in A.A.C. R14-2-2301 et seq. (the "Net Metering Rules") as necessary to authorize the new tariff and the tariff revisions requested in the application.


On April 30, 2015, Arizona Solar Energy Industries Association ("AriSEIA") filed an Application to Intervene. AriSEIA is a non-profit trade association representing local and national companies whose mission is to promote policies that promote greater use of solar energy in Arizona. ARiSEIA asserts that its Board of Directors authorized its Chairman, Mark Holoham to act on its behalf in this matter.

1 On May 7, 2015, Arizona Public Service Company ("APS") filed a Motion to Intervene. APS
2 is a public service corporation providing electric service to customers in Arizona.

3 No party objected to these requests to intervene.

4 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that intervention is granted to AriSEIA and APS.
