Dear Commissioner Forese:

We are customers of Sulfur Springs Valley Electric Cooperative.

We are very concerned and upset on our behalf and on the behalf of others of our friends and relatives throughout Arizona who suddenly find the "rules of the game" changed for solar customers. Although we are "grandfathered in", most of our friends and relatives are not, although they were certainly interested. (And being "grandfathered" doesn't help us any if we want to sell our house!)

What we find most amazing is that SSVEC, TEP, Trico, SRP, and APS suddenly and almost simultaneously discovered a problem with the solar rules and their income. We know that you folks don't control SRP, and we are aware that no two of the companies have quite the same solution to their claimed revenue problems, but all solutions are such that new any solar customers are discouraged.

The value of the energy put into the grid seems to be ignored, and meanwhile at least one of the companies mentioned is planning to buy more fossil-fuel-generated energy. This really seems absurd. Please look into this apparent contradiction.

If all us affected in Arizona must pay a new rate, at least let there be a rate case so the public can find out what's going on.
