PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On April 24, 2015, Midvale Telephone Company, Inc. ("Midvale" or "Company") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission"), an application requesting that the Commission approve an extension of its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CC&N") to provide services to an additional area in Yavapai County.

On May 26, 2015, the Commission's Utilities Division ("Staff") filed a Sufficiency Letter stating that Midvale's amended application for an extension of its CC&N had met the sufficiency requirements as outlined in the Arizona Administrative Code ("A.A.C.").

On June 6, 2015, Staff filed a Corrected Sufficiency Letter removing the word "amended" application from the Sufficiency Letter.


According to Midvale's application, the Company currently holds a CC&N to provide local exchange and toll access services in parts of Arizona. Midvale's request to extend its CC&N fails to specify the types of services it intends to provide if an extension is granted. For purposes of publication, Midvale should clarify the services it intends or proposes to provide if the Commission grants its application.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Midvale shall docket a filing on or before June 15, 2015, clarifying the types of proposed services the Company intends to provide if the Commission grants its application in this docket.
