PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On May 5, 2015, UNS Electric, Inc. ("UNSE" or "Company") filed an Application with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") for a rate increase.

By Procedural Order dated June 22, 2015, the matter was set for hearing and other procedural guidelines established, including the form of the public notice.

UNSE provides service in a several different geographic areas in the state. In order to permit easier public access to the application, it is reasonable to customize where UNSE will make the application available for public inspection. In other rate case proceedings, public libraries have provided such access without complaints, and it is reasonable to permit UNSE to make the application available to the public in local public libraries or other secure locations open to the public.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that UNSE shall replace that portion of the public notice contained in the June 22, 2015 Procedural Order entitled "How You Can View or Obtain a Copy of the Rate Proposal" with the following language:

3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Officer may rescind, alter, amend, or waive
4 any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at hearing.
