BY THE COMMISSION:

The Commission entered Decision No. 74701 on August 21, 2014. Decision No. 74701 provides in relevant part certain modified conditions and requirements for Johnson Utilities, LLC., dba Johnson Utilities Company's ("Company") Central Arizona Groundwater Replenishment District ("CAGR") account adjuster mechanism. On May 22, 2015, the Company filed a request to amend Decision No. 74701 concerning its CAGR account adjuster to remove the limitation that requires the Company to reimburse itself for advancing shortfalls in the CAGR account at the rate of 1/12<sup>th</sup> of the shortfall per month.

After considering the filings in this matter as well as parties' comments at the Open Meeting, the Commission finds that the public interest is served by granting the requested modification to the Company's CAGR account adjuster.

Pursuant to A.R.S. Section 40-252, with notice and opportunity to be heard, the Commission hereby amends Decision No. 74701 to remove the limitation on the Company's CAGR account adjuster that requires the Company to reimburse itself for advancing shortfalls in the CAGR account at the rate of 1/12<sup>th</sup> of the shortfall per month.

1 The Commission has jurisdiction over this subject matter and the Company's request to  
2 amend Decision No.74701.

3 **ORDER**

4 THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 74701 is amended to remove the  
5 limitation on Johnson Utilities, LLC., dba Johnson Utilities Company's CAGR account adjuster  
6 that requires the Company to reimburse itself for advancing shortfalls in the CAGR account at the  
7 rate of 1/12<sup>th</sup> of the shortfall per month.

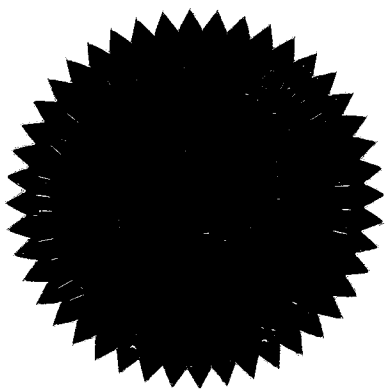
8 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the provisions of Decision No. 74701 not specially
