IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Arizona-American shall notify its customers of the arsenic cost recovery surcharge tariff approved herein within 30 days of the effective date of this Decision.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Company shall file with Docket Control, as a compliance item in this docket, a report showing the Company's ending capital structure by month for the prior year. The first report shall be due on July 1, 2008, and shall be provided each July 1<sup>st</sup> thereafter until such time as a subsequent order of the Commission discontinues the ACRM surcharge.
