Trico's complaint that individual solar energy generators don't pay their fair share of the cost of building and maintaining the grid is baseless. I see no difference between generating my own energy and simply replacing lower efficiency energy devices with higher efficiency ones. In either case Trico will sell less energy. Furthermore, solar energy generators provide power to Trico with no infrastructure cost. All other generating methods require large investments for generators, boilers, and environmental compliance. In the case of individual solar energy, the cost of this power generating asset is borne by the customer and not passed on to Trico. Thus Trico's overall energy providing capability is increased (especially during high demand periods) and their load management is simplified resulting in lower costs, not higher ones.
