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

The new facilities for CAP wheeling Tucson water includes a new G to I-Zone booster station at the Tucson Water G-Zone tank site, which will be primarily under the control and operation of Vail Water. It is anticipated that the CAP booster station has included facilities for a total of three vertical turbine booster pumps, each capable of pumping approximately 800 to 1,000 gpm when operating alone. The new 16-inch transmission main of 9,743 L/F will transport water from the booster station to the Vail Water I-Zone water system located to the east. The transmission pipeline will connect to the I-Zone water system adjacent to the Well No. 5 site. From that location, the existing water system will deliver the water to the I-Zone tanks, in the same fashion as water is currently delivered today.
