On April 24, 2015, Midvale Telephone Company, Inc. ("Midvale" or "Company") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application requesting that the Commission approve an extension of its current Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CC&N"), to provide local exchange and toll access telecommunication services in Yavapai County. The Commission's Utilities Division ("Staff") has not yet made a recommendation regarding the application, and the Commission is not bound by the proposals made by Midvale, Staff, or any intervenors. The Commission will issue a Decision regarding the application following consideration of testimony and evidence presented at an evidentiary hearing. Copies of the applications are available at Midvale's offices at 8800 E. Long Mesa Dr., Prescott Valley, Arizona, 86314 and at the Commission's Docket Control Center at 1200 West Washington, Phoenix, Arizona; for public inspection during regular business hours, and on the internet via the Commission's website ([www.azcc.gov](http://www.azcc.gov)) using the e-Docket function.

The Commission will hold a hearing on the application on **September 1, 2015 at 10:00a.m.**, at the Commission's offices, 1200 West Washington Street, Hearing Room No. 1, Phoenix, Arizona. Public comments will be taken on the first day of the hearing. You may also file your written comments electronically by going to the Commission's homepage at [www.azcc.gov](http://www.azcc.gov) and clicking on the "Submit a Public Comment" button, or by mailing a letter referencing **Docket No. T-20741A-15-0136** to: Arizona Corporation Commission, Consumer Services Section, 1200 West Washington, Phoenix, Arizona 85007.

The law provides for an open public hearing at which, under appropriate circumstances, interested parties may intervene. Any person or entity entitled by law to intervene and having a direct and substantial interest in the matter will be permitted to intervene. If you would like to intervene, you must file an original and 13 copies of a written motion to intervene with the Commission no later than **August 11, 2015**, and send a copy of the motion to Midvale or their counsel and to all parties of record. Your motion to intervene must contain the following:

1. The name, address, and telephone number and the name, address, and telephone number of any party upon whom service of documents is to be made, if not yourself;

2.A short statement of your interest in the proceeding (e.g., a customer of the Company etc.);

3.A statement certifying that you have mailed a copy of the motion to intervene to Midvale or its counsel and to all parties of record in the case; and

4.If the proposed intervenor is not represented by an attorney who is an active member of the Arizona State Bar, and is not an individual representing himself or herself, information and any appropriate documentation demonstrating the intervenor's compliance with Arizona Supreme Court Rules 31, 38, and 42, as applicable.

The granting of motions to intervene shall be governed by A.A.C R14-3-105, except that all motions to intervene must be filed on or before August 11, 2015. For information about requesting intervention, visit the Commission's website at <http://www.azcc.gov/division/utilities/forms/intervene.pdf>. The granting of intervention, among other things, entitles a party to present sworn evidence at hearing and to cross-examine other witnesses. However, failure to intervene will not preclude any interested person or entity from appearing at the hearing and providing public comment on the applications or from filing written comments in the record of the case.
