24. Good morning Chairman Bitter-Smith, and Commissioners. My name is Al Gervenack, Vice President of the
 25. Property Owners and Residents Association commonly referred to by the acronym PORA, representing the
 26. residents of Sun City West (SCW), Arizona.

27. SCW is one of the five Wastewater (WW) Districts identified in this proceeding and PORA is signature to
 28. the Settlement Agreement, Decision No. 74881.

29. The EPCOR request before the Arizona Corporation Commission (ACC) ask for a delay in filing the
 30. required WW Rate Case by September 30, 2015 (Decision No. 74881). EPCOR identified through some of
 31. their supporting statements that the requested delay is the outcome of accounting based issues that were
 32. identified in a recent rate case.

33. PORA is aware of EPCOR's admitted accounting issues and agrees that only the most accurate accounting
 34. data must be available for use in this case. PORA supports the EPCOR request for a delay of the WW rate
 35. case filing from September 30, 2015 to April 29, 2016, using an ending December 31, 2015 test year.

36. In addition, EPCOR provides supporting statements of their confusion for various consolidation,
 37. deconsolidation, and District scenarios. PORA respectfully ask the Commission to note that the Sun City West
 38. WW District has always been and continues to be a stand-alone WW District. In order to maintain a position of
 39. autonomy, the SCW customer's position as a stand-alone District is not confusing and should have very little,
 40. if any, impact or confusion on any of the other proposed scenarios.

41. PORA continues to support the agreement and as stated on page 3, 2.2, of the Settlement Agreement;
