Would the Commission please order that all utilities walk back their arbitrary dates when they will no longer honor NM agreements, or declare that they are invalid and an interference in business as they have already interfered in the legitimate business interests of solar installers? Solar City has, for example, ceased operations in the Trico area.

In short, the ACC should immediately publish an announcement that any changes will be scheduled after a ruling by the ACC sufficiently far in the future to allow any active NM project quote to be completed and will be grandfathered, subject to current NM rule.

Such an order would avoid damage claims, and potential law suits, and be in the public interest.
