INTERVENTION

BY THE COMMISSION:

On March 25, 2015, Tucson Electric Power Company ("TEP" or "Company") filed an Application with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") for : (1) approval of a new net-metering tariff for future net metered customers that provides monthly bill credits for any excess energy produced from an eligible net metering facility at a "Renewable Credit Rate" and (2) approval of a partial waiver of the Commission's Net Metering Rules ("A.A.C. R14-2-2301 *et seq.*).

On April 29, 2015, Western Resource Advocates ("WRA") filed a Motion to Intervene. WRA is a non-profit regional environmental law and policy organization.

On May 7, 2015, Arizona Public Service Company ("APS"), a public service corporation providing electric service to customers within Arizona, filed a Motion to Intervene.

There were no objections filed to the intervention requests.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that intervention is granted to WRA and APS.¹
