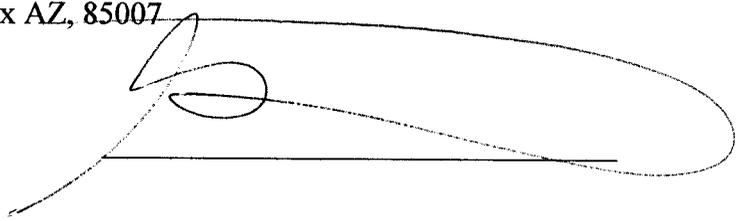
Reply Brief on Interim Net Metering Solution

The AzCPA's position in this case is closely aligned with those of both RUCO and Staff. On the legal issue, we agree that the ACC has the authority to adjudicate the current APS filing outside of the bounds of a rate case. On the policy issue, we agree with Staff that the ACC would have many more options if it chose to handle the issues in a rate case. Indeed, we believe that the ACC will ultimately choose to deal with many of the fundamental issues that APS has raised in the context of a full rate case. However, we believe that the RUCO argument on timing trumps the Staff argument on flexibility. If APS does indeed file a rate case in the 2nd quarter of 2016, the final outcome of that case would likely be decided in the 3rd quarter of 2017. That is simply too long to wait. The AzCPA believes that the ACC should act on the APS filing by adjusting the LFCR now—and possibly in the summer of 2016 as well—while working on a comprehensive solution that can be implemented at the end of the company's next rate case in 2017.
