## **INTRODUCTION**

On December 23, 2011, Main Street Telephone Company ("Main Street" or "Applicant") submitted an Application to cancel its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CC&N") to provide competitive resold interexchange telecommunications services within the State of Arizona.

## **BACKGROUND**

Main Street was granted a CC&N by the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") to provide competitive resold interexchange telecommunications service in Decision No. 63907, dated August 6, 2001.

## **STAFF'S ANALYSIS**

In its Application, Main Street indicated that it has no customers in the State of Arizona. Main Street indicated that it longer intends to retain its authority and requested the cancellation of its authority to provide resold long distance telecommunications in Arizona.

Pursuant to Arizona Administrative Code ("A.A.C.") R14-2-1107(B), Main Street is required to publish legal notice of an Application to discontinue or abandon local exchange or interexchange services in all counties affected by the Application. In its Response to Staff Data Request JFB 1-10, Main Street indicated that it ceased all operations on June 17, 2011. Given that Main Street no longer provides service, Staff recommends that the notice requirement pursuant to A.A.C. R14-2-1107(B) be waived.

According to the Corporations Division, Main Street did not file its 2011 Annual Report and as a result its registration was revoked. The Consumer Services Section of the Utilities Division reports that there were no complaints or opinions filed against Coast from January 1, 2009 through April 10, 2015.

## **RECOMMENDATIONS**

Main Street Telephone Company no longer provides resold long distance to any customers in Arizona and it never collected deposits, advances or prepayments from Arizona customers. Staff recommends that Main Street Telephone Company's CC&N to provide resold interexchange telecommunications services be cancelled.

Upon cancellation of its CC&N, Main Street Telephone Company will no longer be authorized to provide resold interexchange telecommunications services in Arizona and will no longer be a public service corporation subject to Commission regulation. Therefore, Main Street Telephone Company will no longer be subject to the requirements of Decision No. 63907.
