19 Pursuant to the Rules of Practice and Procedure of the Arizona Corporation Commission  
20 (“Commission”), Vote Solar hereby moves for leave to intervene in the above-captioned docket  
21 and, in support thereof, states as follows:

22 1. Vote Solar is a nonprofit working to foster economic opportunity, promote energy  
23 security and fight climate change by making solar a mainstream energy resource. Vote Solar  
24 works at the state level all across the country to support the policies and programs needed to  
25 repower the grid with sunshine.

1           2.       Vote Solar seeks to promote the development of distributed generation solar  
2 resources, wholesale distributed generation and solar thermal electric large-scale solar. Vote  
3 Solar is working to implement the policies necessary to build robust solar markets in key states  
4 including Arizona. Vote Solar has previously participated in other dockets at the Commission  
5 including the rulemaking docket associated with the adoption of the renewable energy standard  
6 and tariff rules.
