Having considered the entire record herein and being fully advised in the premises, the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") finds, concludes, and orders that:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On May 22, 1998, in Decision No. 60899, the Commission granted Association Administrators, Inc. ("AAI" or "Company") a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CC&N") to provide competitive resold interexchange telecommunication services within the State of Arizona.

2. On April 1, 2015, AAI filed a request to cancel its CC&N, stating that AAI was no longer providing telecommunication services in Arizona and had ceased doing business in Arizona no later than December 31, 2014. The Company further requested a waiver of the notice requirements in Arizona Administrative Code ("A.A.C.") R14-2-1107, asserting that AAI no longer had customers in Arizona with which to provide notice.

3. On May 15, 2015, the Commission's Utilities Division ("Staff") filed a Staff Report in this matter recommending approval of AAI's application to cancel its CC&N.

4. According to the Staff Report, the Commission's Compliance Section reported that the Company has no delinquent compliance issues. The Consumer Services Section of the Utilities

1 Division indicated that no complaints, inquiries, or opinions had been filed against the Company
2 from January 1, 2012 to May 11, 2015. The Corporations Division reported AAI's registration had
3 been revoked for failing to file Annual Reports for the years 2013 and 2014.

4 5. A.A.C. R14-2-1107 requires that an application to discontinue service include
5 verification that all affected customers have been notified of the proposed discontinuance and that all
6 affected customers will have access to an alternative provider. Staff recommends granting AAI's
7 request to waive the published notice requirements of A.A.C. R14-2-1107 because the Company is
8 not providing resold long distance telecommunication services to any customers in Arizona. Staff
9 further recommends cancellation of AAI's tariff that is on file with the Commission.

10 6. Staff's recommendations are reasonable and should be adopted.

11 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

12 1. Association Administrators, Inc. is a public service corporation within the meaning of
13 Article XV of the Arizona Constitution and A.R.S. §§ 40-281 and 40-282.

14 2. The Commission has jurisdiction over Association Administrators, Inc. and the subject
15 matter of the application.

16 3. The cancellation of Association Administrators, Inc.'s Certificate of Convenience and
17 Necessity to provide competitive resold interexchange telecommunications services and to cancel its
18 tariff on file with the Commission for such services is in the public interest.

19 4. The Company has waived a hearing in this matter.

20 5. Staff's recommendations are reasonable and should be adopted.

21 **ORDER**

22 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the application of Association Administrators, Inc. for
23 the cancellation of its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity, granted in Commission Decision No.
24 60899 (May 2, 1998), to provide competitive resold interexchange telecommunications in Arizona is
25 hereby approved and the Certificate of Convenience and Necessity is canceled.

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1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Association Administrators, Inc.'s telecommunication
2 services tariff on file with the Commission is hereby canceled.

3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Decision shall become effective immediately.
