



**APPLICATION TO
ELIMINATE BOND REQUIREMENT**

EnTelegent Solutions, Inc. ("EnTelegent") hereby requests elimination of the \$100,000 bond requirement set as a condition in Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") Decision No. 71780. There is good reason to do so without customer harm.

EnTelegent was incorporated in North Carolina on November 6, 2008 and is registered as a Foreign Corporation in Arizona. The Commission authorized EnTelegent to provide resold long distance, facilities-based local exchange, and switched access telecommunications services on July 12, 2010 in Decision No. 71780.

In addition to Arizona, EnTelegent is certificated as a CLEC in the following states: Alabama,, Arkansas, California, Colorado, Connecticut, Delaware, District of Columbia, Florida, Georgia, Hawaii, Idaho, Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Kansas, Kentucky, Louisiana , Maryland, Massachusetts, Michigan, Missouri, Mississippi, Nebraska, Nevada, New Jersey, New Mexico, New York, Ohio, Oklahoma, Oregon, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, South Carolina, South Dakota, Tennessee, Texas, Utah, Vermont, Virginia, Washington, West Virginia, and Wisconsin. EnTelegent operates as a reseller in Arizona as well as the other states it operates in.

EnTelegent is aware that both Delaware and Maine have eliminated their requirements for CLECs to maintain a bond. EnTelegent is no longer required to maintain a bond in state of Colorado. Colorado required a bond for a three year period after EnTelegent received certification and three years passed in August 2013. In the 43 states EnTelegent is certificated, only five other states require EnTelegent to maintain a bond.

The Commission has in some cases not required a performance bond or has relieved CLECs of the requirement to obtain a bond. EnTelegent respectfully requests the Commission eliminate the requirement for EnTelegent to maintain a surety bond. EnTelegent believes there is good reason to do so and it will not result in any customer harm. EnTelegent offers postpaid resold services to business customers only. EnTelegent does not collect customer deposits in Arizona.

The Commission's Competitive Telecommunications Services Rules, A.A.C. 14-2-1101 through 14-2-1115, do not require that EnTelegent maintain a performance bond as a condition or providing service in Arizona. Specifically, A.A.C. R14-2-1105(D) states that the Commission "*may require, as a precondition to certification, the procurement of a performance bond sufficient to cover any advances or deposits the telecommunications company may collect from its customers, or order that such advances or deposits the telecommunications company may collect from its customers, or order that such advances or deposits be held in escrow or trust.*" This means that the Commission has the flexibility to determine if a bond requirement is still necessary for EnTelegent.


EnTelegent resells services of Qwest Corporation dba CenturyLink QC and Verizon California, Inc. to business customers only. EnTelegent does not collect customer deposits in Arizona. EnTelegent remains in good standing in Arizona and in all other states it operates in.

EnTelegent respectfully requests the Commission eliminate the requirement for EnTelegent to maintain a \$100,000 performance bond.
