Re: Support for GRIC route for Price Road Corridor's 230kV powerline


We are the officers and Board members of the Comanche Heights Homeowner Association (HOA). Our community, which is also called Talanté, is located in Chandler along Germann Road, just west of Alma School Road. Our community of 61 families fully supports the GRIC route for the 230kV high voltage power line placement of the Price Road Corridor project.

We are requesting that the members of the ACC Siting Committee **vote YES on the current proposed route** that SRP has recently filed (Docket # L-00000B-15-0059-00170). We believe this is the best route for all of South Chandler and for the Gila River Indian Community (GRIC). By approving SRP's preferred route, the ACC will avoid setting a statewide precedent of allowing high-voltage power lines to be built in existing, densely populated communities. The 230kV power lines do not belong on Germann Road, a built-out, highly populated residential community. Voting to approve the GRIC route will also benefit our neighbors, the Gila River Indian Community. The Allottees in the tribe have overwhelming approved the route.

SRP's preferred route offers a win-win situation for all involved; it will provide the least impact on densely populated private land, while providing the economic and new technology benefits that the Gila River Indian Community Allottees voted for.

Our community joins with SRP, GRIC and the City of Chandler to officially and enthusiastically support approval of the Price Road Corridor GRIC route.
