The following same or similar comments were filed by 37 people IN FAVOR of the Line Siting Application -

I am asking that you vote YES to SRP's recent application, Docket # L-00000B-15-0059-00170. A GRIC route stops a precedent of adding high voltage power lines to built up, densely populated communities. The elimination of the private land routes along Germann, Dobson, and Ellis Roads has the support of HOA groups, schools, daycares, churches, retail businesses, as well as the City of Chandler. Under no circumstances should the Germann route be an option. Traditionally, these power lines are built along highways, open and undeveloped land, canals, and railroads; this is where they belong. Voting to approve the GRIC route will benefit our neighbors, the Gila River Indian Community. The Allottees in the tribe have overwhelmingly approved the route. Overall, this is a win-win situation for all involved; it will provide the least impact on densely populated private land and is supported by GATE, SRP, GRIC, and the City of Chandler.
