

NOTICE OF OPEN MEETING

An Open Meeting will be held by the Arizona Corporation Commission (Commission) regarding Arizona Public Service Company's (APS) request to extend the term of the Certificate of Environmental Compatibility (CEC) in the above referenced docket. In Decision No. 67828, the Commission granted APS authorization to construct approximately 25 miles of a double-circuit 230kV transmission line with a 69kV underbuild, one 230kV substation, and one 500kV/230kV substation. APS has requested an extension for an additional five years to May 5, 2020 for the first circuit of the 230kV transmission line, and for an additional five years to May 5, 2030 for the second circuit. Additionally, APS gives the Commission notice that the Trilby Wash Substation (formerly TS1) is located on up to 15 acres of land.

The Open Meeting will be held at the Arizona Corporation Commission, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona 85007, Hearing Room One on April 14 or 15, 2015 at 10:00 a.m. We encourage you to monitor the Commission's website at www.azcc.gov for the specific date and time the Commission plans to consider the time extension.
