RE: ARIZONA WATER COMPANY - REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF COMPLIANCE DEADLINES (DOCKET NO. W-01445A-05-0389)

In Decision No. 68442, dated February 2, 2006, the Arizona Corporation Commission ("ACC" or "Commission") approved the application of Arizona Water Company ("Arizona Water") for an extension of its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CC&N"). Decision No. 68442 ordered the following:

- a) "...that the Company file, within 365 days of the effective date of this Decision, with the Commission's Docket Control, as a compliance item, a copy of the respective developer's Certificate of Assured Water Supply issued by the Arizona Department of Water Resources for the areas described in Exhibit A."
- b) "...that the Company file, within 365 days of the effective date of this Decision, with the Commission's Docket Control, as a compliance item, copies of any executed main extension agreements."
- c) "...that the Company file, within 365 days of the effective date of this Decision, with the Commission's Docket Control, as a compliance item, copies of the respective Certificates of Approval to Construct issued by the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality for the construction mains in the three extension areas."

Decision No. 68442 obligated the Company to provide each of the above filings for each of three separate parcels. Parcel One is owned by Skousen & Highway 87, Parcel Two is owned by Lorenson Land and Cattle and Parcel Three is owned by Vail 160, L.L.C. The Company originally had 365 days, until February 2, 2007, to provide these filings to the Commission and has received extensions of time (most recently in Decision No. 74007) until February 2, 2015.

Decision No. 72247 previously confirmed that the compliance items were completed for Parcels One and Two. The Company also docketed the Approval to Construct ("ATC") for Parcel Three on June 14, 2013. Therefore, the Certificate of Assured Water Supply ("CAWS") and Main Extension Agreement ("MXA") for Parcel Three represent the remaining compliance requirements in this case.

On November 5, 2014, Arizona Water Company docketed a subsequent request for extension of time, until February 2, 2017, for the provision of the CAWS and the MXA for Parcel Three. The application argues that "the Company has substantially complied with the requirements of the Decision" and confirms that the remaining compliance items concern only Parcel 3. Additionally, the application includes an updated request for service letter from Vail 160, L.L.C., the sole Parcel 3 landowner.

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Based on the application and all of the above, Staff does not object to the Company request for an extension of time in this matter. Staff therefore recommends that the due date for the requirement for provision of the CAWS and the MXA for Parcel 3 be extended to February 2, 2017.
