First, thank you for the opportunity to comment. Second, I appreciate the work you are putting forth in regards to making an informative decision regarding where/how the new power lines should be placed.

Second, I am an Arizona Native and moved to Chandler 15 years ago because of the school system, the cleanliness of the City, the economics, and the overall quality of life I thought the City provided my family and I. We have been nothing but extremely happy with our decision to make our home in Chandler and the beautiful community of Pinelake Estates where we have resided for the last 11 years. Unfortunately, if said power lines are erected, we will unfortunately be forced to regret the decision of moving to Chandler and building in Pinelake Estates.

I am pro business and pro technology. For the last 17 years, I have been in technology and a lot of my clients reside on the Price Road Technology Corridor. I also am in support for continuing to build out said corridor with additional technology businesses and I also understand that in order to build out the new corridor, there must be additional power. However, with that being said, I am not in support with the proposed way of getting said power to the corridor.

As a proud Chandler resident, I am frankly disgusted that the placement of these Power lines has caused entire neighbor hoods to be at odds with one another. I understand that no one wants these Power Lines erected anywhere near their homes for a single fact that it decreases property values, causes an "eye sore", and leads to many documented health risks, especially to younger children. If the power lines are erected above ground, it will be a "great tragedy" for the entire Chandler/Ocotillo community.

I understand that there is an additional cost to bury the lines. At one point, SRP mentioned that the costs was 10X, however, from my understanding they have never released a study that would show the "true" cost

U understand there is a need for the Technology Corridor, However, I can't understand why the great citizens of Chandler have been put in a position to "fight" against one another (community vs. community) as to where these lines will be erected. That is why I beg/plead /pray that your strong recommendation will be to bury the lines, no matter the cost. Because, if the lines are not buried, it may same cost, but it will be a travesty and loss to the City and the City will me, my family, and a lot of its current residents.
