PROCEDURAL ORDER

12 **BY THE COMMISSION:**

13 On March 25, 2015, UNS Electric, Inc. ("UNSE" or "Company") filed an Application with
14 the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") for : (1) approval of a new net-metering tariff
15 for future net metered customers that provides monthly bill credits for any excess energy produced
16 from an eligible net metering facility at a "Renewable Credit Rate" and (2) approval of a partial
17 waiver of the Commission's Net Metering Rules ("A.A.C. R14-2-2301 *et seq.*). UNSE requested that
18 the Commission set this matter for a hearing in a time frame to allow the Commission to consider the
19 matter at an open meeting before December 31, 2015.

20 On April 3, 2015, UNSE filed a Notice of Waiver of any 30-day "time clock" that would
21 apply to the Company's Application.

22 On April 14, 2015, the Commission's Utilities Division ("Staff") filed a Motion to
23 Consolidate this matter with UNSE's expected rate case.¹

24 By Procedural Order dated April 16, 2015, a Procedural Conference for the purpose of
25 discussing a process for considering Staff's Motion was scheduled for April 27, 2015.

26 On April 21, 2015, UNSE filed a Motion to Withdraw Application. UNSE stated that
27 although it believes a rate case is not legally required for the Commission to grant the relief requested
28 in the Application, it is willing to accept Staff's request and have the matters raised in the Application



1 considered as part of its rate case. Thus, UNSE requested that its Application be withdrawn without
2 prejudice.

3 At the April 27, 2015 Procedural Conference, UNSE reiterated its request to withdraw the
4 Application and have the matter considered as part of its rate case expected to be filed in a few
5 weeks. No party objected.

6 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that UNSE's **Application is dismissed without prejudice**
7 **and the docket shall be administratively closed.**
