Trico Electric Cooperative has effectively stopped the solar market in its territory by unilaterally changing its solar net metering tariff on February 28, 2015. This tariff change is illegal in that it changes a tariff before the ACC has made a decision on Trico's application for a new tariff. (See Docket # E-01461A-15-0057). ACC Rules at R14-2-212F(3) state clearly : "Any proposed change to the tariffs on file with the Commission shall not be effective until reviewed and approved by the Commission."

And, of course, a later decision by the Commission to approve the proposed tariff, should that occur, could only be prospective to avoid a concern of retroactive ratemaking. Quite obviously, any customer who could have applied for interconnection approval and kWh credit under the existing tariff who was prevented or discouraged from filing has been injured by Trico's actions.

The Commission should order Trico to honor its tariff immediately and advertise this change to members
