NOTIFICATION OF INTERVENTION

BY THE COMMISSION:

On May 5, 2015, UNS Electric, Inc. ("UNSE" or "Company") filed an Application with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") for a rate increase. By Procedural Order dated June 22, 2015, the matter was set for hearing to commence on March 1, 2016, and other procedural guidelines were established.

On July 15, 2015, Southwest Energy Efficiency Project ("SWEEP") filed a Motion to Intervene. SWEEP is a non-profit public interest organization promoting greater energy efficiency.

On July 16, 2015, the Arizona Investment Council ("AIC") filed a Motion for Leave to Intervene.<sup>1</sup> AIC is a membership organization, of Arizona utilities and individuals who hold stock or debt in Arizona utilities, and states that its mission includes promoting policies that encourage utility investment and infrastructure development in Arizona and the interests of debt and equity investors in Arizona utilities.

On July 17, 2015, Arizonans for Electric Choice and Competition ("AECC") filed for Leave to Intervene. AECC is a coalition of energy consumers which is dedicated to protecting and promoting the interests of large industrial and commercial retail electric rate payers.

1 There were no objections filed to these intervention requests.

2 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that **intervention is granted to SWEEP, AIC, and AECC.**

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
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
