Pursuant to Decision No. 74821 (November 13, 2014), Tucson Electric Power Company (TEP) of the "Company") hereby provides a status report on the Company's Voluntary Solar Contribution Program ("VSC Program").

TEP and UNS Electric, Inc. ("UNS Electric") are wholly-owned subsidiaries of UNS Energy Corporation. UNS Electric, in Docket No. E-04204A-13-0225, is filing an identical compliance report pursuant to Decision No. 74822 (November 13, 2014).

VCS Program Fund

In December 2014, TEP and UNS Electric contributed a total of \$25,500 to a single fund called the Tucson Electric Power Company and UNS Electric Voluntary Solar Program Fund (the "Fund"). The Fund is managed on behalf of TEP and UNS Electric by the Arizona Community Foundation ("ACF"). Contributions to the Fund are designated for the installation of solar panel systems on newly built residential single-family homes constructed by the Arizona chapters of Habitat for Humanity International ("Habitat") on Habitat homes for either TEP or UNS Electric customers.

- On May 4, 2015, both TEP and UNS Electric used Facebook and Twitter to promote the program via social media. Combined, TEP and UniSource Energy Services ("UES," parent company of UNS Electric and UNS Gas, Inc.) have more than 19,000 Facebook "likes" and nearly 6,000 Twitter followers.
- The May 7, 2015 issue of TEP's customer newsletter, Plugged In, contained a story about the VSC Program. Fund Contributions

From the inception of the Fund to September 30, 2015, there have been donations of \$626.69. These contributions came from four donors.

Fund Balance

As of September 30, 2015, the Fund's balance was \$25,855.09 (including net investment returns). Fund-related expenses include: an administrative fee of 1% of the Fund balance or \$500, whichever is greater; and an annual fee of \$500 to maintain an online donation page on ACF's website.

System Installations

As of September 30, 2015, there have been no solar installations funded by the VSC Program.
