PROCEDURAL ORDER

20 **BY THE COMMISSION:**

21 On June 9, 2015, Mobilitie, LLC (“Mobilitie” or “Company”), filed with the Arizona
22 Corporation Commission (“Commission”) an application for a Certificate of Convenience and
23 Necessity (“CC&N”) to provide radio frequency transport service to enable other carriers, including,
24 but not limited to, wireless telecommunications service providers, to provision the direct transmission
25 of voice communications and data services in the state of Arizona.

26 On July 6, 2015, the Commission’s Utilities Division (“Staff”) filed a Letter of Sufficiency
27 stating that Mobilitie’s application was sufficient under the requirements of the Arizona Administrative
28 Code (“A.A.C.”).

On July 30, 2015, a Procedural Order was issued setting a hearing in the matter for October 19,
2015, and outlining a procedural schedule.

On October 6, 2015, Mobilitie filed a Request to Allow Witness and Counsel to Appear
Telephonically. The Company requested that its witness, Ethan Rogers, the Company’s Corporate
Counsel, and the Company’s Local Counsel, be allowed to appear telephonically at the October 19,
2015, hearing.

1 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Mobilitie's witness and Corporate Counsel may appear
2 telephonically.

3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Mobilitie's Local Counsel shall appear in person before the
4 Commission for the hearing.

5 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that on the date of and at least five minutes before the time set
6 for the hearing, Mobilitie's witness and Corporate Counsel shall call 1 (888) 450-5996, passcode
7 457395#, from a landline telephone, to participate telephonically in the procedural conference.

8 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113-Unauthorized
9 Communications) continues to apply to this proceeding as the matter is set for public hearing.

10 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter, amend, or
11 waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at
12 hearing.


