PROCEDURAL ORDER GRANTING

BY THE COMMISSION:

On May 5, 2015, UNS Electric, Inc. ("UNS" or "Company") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application to determine the fair value of the utility property of the Company for ratemaking purposes, to fix a just and reasonable rate of return thereon, and to approve rate schedules designed to develop such return.

On August 12, 2015, pursuant to Arizona Supreme Court Rule 38(a), Timothy M. Hogan, an attorney for Vote Solar, filed with the Commission a Motion to Associate Counsel *Pro Hac Vice* for Katie Dittelberger in the above-captioned matter ("Motion"). 

18 withdraw by the Administrative Law Judge.
