FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On June 26, 2015, EnTelegent Solutions, Inc. ("EnTelegent" or "Applicant") submitted an Application requesting elimination of the bond or letter of credit requirement contained in Decision No. 71780.

Background

2. On July 21, 2009, in anticipation of receiving Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") approval of its request for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity, EnTelegent filed proof that it had delivered to the Commission's Business Office an original bond in the amount of \$100,000.¹ In Decision No. 71780, dated July 12, 2010, the Commission ordered that this bond should remain on file with the Commission until further order of the Commission.

1 3. Staff has confirmed the Business Office is in possession of the original \$100,000 bond
2 mentioned here. EnTelegent is requesting the return of the \$100,000 bond to the contact listed
3 below.

4 **Compliance**

5 4. According to the Commission Corporations Division, EnTelegent is in good standing.
6 The Compliance Section of the Utilities Division reports that EnTelegent is currently in compliance.
7 The Consumer Services Section of the Utilities Division reports there have been no complaints or
8 opinions about EnTelegent between January 1, 2012 and July 1, 2015. EnTelegent filed its 2014
9 Utilities Annual Report on April 14, 2015.

10 **Staff Recommendations**

11 5. The Commission has, in appropriate circumstances, relieved telecommunications
12 providers of the obligation to maintain a performance bond or irrevocable sight draft letter of credit
13 (“ISDLOC”). Staff recommends EnTelegent be relieved of the \$100,000 performance bond
14 obligation contained in Decision No. 71780.

15 6. The Applicant states that in order to release the bond, it is sufficient for the
16 Commission to include in an ordering paragraph language authorizing the Applicant to cancel, rescind,
17 discontinue and be released from the performance bond or ISDLOC requirements set by Decision
18 No. 71780 and authorizing the cancellation of the bond.

27 CONCLUSIONS OF LAW


28 1. EnTelegent Solutions, Inc. is a public service corporation within the meaning of

2 EnTelegent Solutions, Inc. be returned to the following name and address provided by the Applicant:




