

## INTRODUCTION

On April 15, 2015, Ms. Joan L. Parker, on behalf of TelLogic, Inc. dba Quality Telephone ("TI" or "Company") submitted a letter requesting cancellation of its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CC&N") to provide resold local exchange telecommunications services within the State of Arizona effective immediately.

## BACKGROUND

On December 9, 2003, in Decision No. 66611, the Commission granted TI a CC&N to provide resold local exchange telecommunications services within the State of Arizona. On April 8, 2009, TI filed proof of a performance bond in the amount of \$25,000, effective on March 31, 2009 with an expiration date of March 31, 2010.

## STAFF'S ANALYSIS

In its April 15, 2015 letter, TI stated it is no longer providing service or doing business in Arizona and stopped providing service in Arizona by no later than September 7, 2012. Because it has no customers in Arizona, there were no customers to notify and TI requests a waiver of the notice of discontinuance of services to customers in Arizona Administrative Code ("A.A.C.") R14-2-1107(A)(1). In addition, because there are no customers, no counties are affected by the discontinuance of service and TI also requests a waiver of the published notice requirements in affected counties in A.A.C. R14-2-1107(B).

The Consumer Services Section of the Utilities Division reports that from January 1, 2012 to April 22, 2015, there have been no complaints, inquiries, or opinions against TI. TI had not filed a Utilities Annual Report since April 22, 2011 for the year ending December 31, 2010. According to the Corporations Division, TI's registration has been revoked and is not in good standing due to outstanding Corporations Division Annual Reports for 2013, 2014 and 2015. The Compliance Section reports that there are no current compliance delinquencies for TI.

## RECOMMENDATION

TI is not currently providing resold local exchange telecommunications services to any customers in Arizona. As such, Staff recommends approval of TI's request for a waiver of the requirements to provide direct notice to affected customers and publish notice contained in A.A.C. R14-2-1107. Staff recommends that TI's CC&N to provide resold local exchange telecommunications services be cancelled. Upon cancellation of its CC&N, TI will no longer be

authorized to provide competitive facilities-based local exchange and long distance telecommunications services in Arizona and therefore, will no longer be subject to the requirements of Decision No. 66611.
