**REQUEST TO DISCONTINUE
AND CANCEL SERVICE**

SECOND AMENDED APPLICATION TO DISCONTINUE AND CANCEL SERVICE

On June 4, 2015, Globalinx Enterprises, Inc. ("Globalinx") through undersigned counsel and pursuant to Arizona Administrative Code R14-2-1107 herein filed an Application to discontinue the provision of interstate long distance service ("Application").

On August 12, 2015 a First Amended Application to Discontinue and Cancel Service was filed due to a discrepancy which was discovered during the Staff review process which indicated the presence of an additional CC&N for facilities-based local exchange services. The company never provided local exchange services and that Amendment requested the withdrawal of the CC&N issued in Docket -03714A-01-0805 on August 22, 2002 in addition to the original long distance authority.

An additional discrepancy was discovered by Staff which is being addressed in this filing for clarity. Globalinx also requests the cancellation of its authority to provide resold long distance telecommunications as granted in Decision No. 62281, dated February 1, 2000, and cancellation of its authority to provide facilities-based and resold local exchange and exchange access telecommunications services in Arizona as granted in Decision No. 65126, dated 8/22/2002.

Globalinx herein certifies that all affected customer has been notified of the proposed discontinuance and that all of its affected customers have access to other long distance service providers such as Birch, Verizon, Sprint as well as others.

Globalinx requests a waiver of Arizona Administrative Code R14-2-1107(B).

Globalinx further certifies that it has not accepted nor does it retain any customer deposits.

WHEREFORE, Globalinx, based upon the foregoing, respectfully requests that the Commission issue an order:

1. Granting Globalinx's request to discontinue the authority issued to provide facilities-based local exchange service within the State of Arizona without the necessity of a hearing;
2. Once all statutory waiting periods have expired that Globalinx's Certificate of Convenience and Necessity be canceled and its tariff(s) be withdrawn; and
3. For all just and equitable relief.
