16 Pursuant to the Rules of Practice and Procedure of the Arizona Corporation Commission
17 (“Commission”), Vote Solar hereby moves for leave to intervene in the above-captioned docket
18 and, in support thereof, states as follows:

19 1. Vote Solar is a nonprofit working to foster economic opportunity, promote energy
20 security and fight climate change by making solar a mainstream energy resource. Vote Solar
21 works at the state level across the country to support the policies and programs needed to bring
22 solar to scale.

23 2. Vote Solar seeks to promote the development of distributed generation solar
24 resources, wholesale distributed generation and large-scale solar. Vote Solar is working to
25 implement, maintain and enhance the policies necessary to build robust solar markets in key
states including Arizona. Vote Solar has previously participated in other dockets at the

1 Commission including the rulemaking docket associated with the adoption of the renewable
2 energy standard and tariff rules.

3 3. Vote Solar is familiar with the issues in this case and its intervention will not
4 unduly broaden the issues or delay the proceeding.




