PROCEDURAL ORDER
**(Amends November 10, 2015
Procedural Order)**

BY THE COMMISSION:

On July 28, 2015, Appaloosa Water Company ("Appaloosa" or "Company") filed an application with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") for approval of a rate increase.

On September 29, 2015, Staff issued a Letter of Sufficiency stating that Appaloosa's application had met the sufficiency standards set forth in the Arizona Administrative Code R14-2-103 and that Appaloosa had been classified as a Class D utility.

On November 6, 2015, Staff filed a Request for an Extension of Time to File Staff Report, stating that the Company's response to Staff's First Set of Data Requests had not been timely and that Staff needed additional time, until December 28, 2015, to file the Staff Report in this matter ("Request").

On November 10, 2015, a Procedural Order was issued granting Staff's Request for an extension of time to file its Staff Report.

The Procedural Order granted Staff's Request, but erroneously stated that the extension of time was granted until December 13, 2015, rather than December 28, 2015. Therefore, the November 10, 2015, Procedural Order should be amended to grant Staff's Request for an extension of time, until December 28, 2015, to file the Staff Report in this matter.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Procedural Order issued on November 10, 2015, is hereby amended to reflect that Staff's Request for an extension of time, until **December 28, 2015**, to file the Staff Report in this matter is hereby granted.

1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the timeclock in this matter remains suspended.

2 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all parties must comply with Arizona Supreme Court Rules
3 31, 38, and 42 and Arizona Revised Statutes § 40-243 with respect to the practice of law and admission
4 *pro hac vice*.

5 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that withdrawal of representation must be made in compliance
6 with A.A.C. R14-3-104(E) and Rule 1.16 of the Rules of Professional Conduct (under Arizona
7 Supreme Court Rule 42). Representation before the Commission includes appearances at all hearings
8 and procedural conferences, as well as all Open Meetings for which the matter is scheduled for
9 discussion unless counsel has previously been granted permission to withdraw by the Administrative
10 Law Judge or the Commission.

11 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter, amend, or
12 waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at
13 hearing.


